CERTIFICATE COURSE ON DISCERNMENT

Introduction

The "Discernment" course is designed to equip believers with the ability to distinguish between truth and deception, good and evil, and the spiritual forces at work in various situations. Over three months, students will explore biblical foundations, practical applications, and spiritual principles necessary for developing and exercising discernment in their daily lives and ministries. Through lectures, readings, and assignments, participants will gain a deeper understanding of the gift of discernment and how to apply it effectively.

Month 1: Foundations of Discernment

Week 1: Introduction to Discernment

- Lecture: Understanding Discernment
 - Definition and importance of discernment
 - Discernment as a spiritual gift
 - Key Scriptures: Hebrews 5:14, 1 Corinthians 12:10
- **Reading:** "The Discerner" by James W. Goll (Chapters 1-2)
- **Assignment:** Write a reflection on the significance of discernment in the life of a believer.

Week 2: Biblical Foundations of Discernment
